

CHILD REFERRAL CHECKLIST

DIRECTIONS: USE THIS CHECKLIST TO HELP DETERMINE WHETHER A CHILD MAY NEED TO BE REFERRED FOR SERVICES OUTSIDE OF THE SCHOOL OR DAY CARE CENTER. IF TWO OR MORE ITEMS ARE CHECKED, CONSIDER GETTING OUTSIDE ASSISTANCE WITH THE CHILD'S PROBLEMS.

- _____ 1. THE CHILD HAS A PROBLEM SEVERE ENOUGH TO INTERFERE WITH SCHOOL FUNCTIONING.
- _____ 2. THE PROBLEM IS UNDIAGNOSED.
- _____ 3. THE CHILD'S PROBLEM HAS BEEN DIAGNOSED, BUT THERAPEUTIC EFFORTS TO DATE HAVE NOT HELPED.
- _____ 4. PLANS DEVELOPED BY TEACHERS TO HELP THE CHILD HAVE BEEN UNSUCCESSFUL.
- _____ 5. THE CHILD'S PARENTS HAVE EXPRESSED SERIOUS CONCERN ABOUT THE CHILD.
- _____ 6. TEACHERS AND STAFF OUTSIDE OF THE CHILD'S CLASSROOM HAVE TAKEN NOTE OF OR COMMENTED ON THE PROBLEM.
- _____ 7. TEACHERS OR OTHER QUALIFIED STAFF HAVE OBSERVED THE CHILD AND AGREE THAT OUTSIDE ASSISTANCE IS NEEDED.
- _____ 8. THE CHILD'S PROBLEM INTERFERES WITH FAMILY FUNCTIONING.
- _____ 9. OTHER CHILDREN IN THE CLASSROOM ARE BEING NEGATIVELY AFFECTED BY THE CHILD.
- _____ 10. THE CHILD OR FAMILY HAS A FAMILY OF SOCIAL, EMOTIONAL, PHYSICAL, OR COGNITIVE DISABILITIES.
